- 3. Three friends record themselves playing funny pranks on one another. They post the videos on their social media pages.
- 4. Alyssa takes an unflattering picture of her big sister while she is sleeping then posts the picture without her sister's permission.
- 5. Kayla posts the negative hashtag #fatandugly about another girl on her social media page. Then she tells her friends to repost the negative message on their pages.
- 6. Jayden makes a cooking video and posts it to his social media channel. A viewer comments, "Cooking is for girls! You must be gay!"
- 7. Heaven posts a video of herself dancing. A viewer comments, "You are fat and uqly!"
- 8. Gianna and her friends create a social media channel with videos of them making slime. A viewer likes one of their videos and subscribes to their channel. This same viewer posts the comment, "I don't like foam slime because it's too sticky."

- 9. Daria and her brother form a band and post a video of their first performance on social media. A viewer comments, "You guys messed up that song!"
- 10. Madison posts pictures from her birthday party. One of her friends comments, "This party was so lame!"
